Progress to Date

The demolition works are well underway with the main structure of the old school now demolished. We thank the neighbouring public for your patience with the inevitable ongoing noise levels occurring from the demolishing works. The noise levels should reduce coming into the new year as the demolition comes to an end and the Sports pitch construction commences. We have also been clearing out the woodland area to the south of the site in preparation for the new woodland footpath and seating areas.







Looking ahead

The demolishing works will come to an end after the Christmas break and we will commence the sports construction in the new year. The woodland footpath and seating areas will commence in the coming weeks creating an enjoyable environment that allows the pupils proper access to the area for recreational use. There will be a slight increase in traffic in the weeks leading up to Christmas due to earth materials having to be removed off site to prepare the site for oncoming works. Morrison will make sure the adjacent roads will be regularly cleaned during this process.





Safe Environment for all

We have been using the school's old entrance for access to the site on Ashburnham road for the last few months and will continue using this throughout the contract until we remove this entrance for the final landscaping in the spring time. Ongoing we will be regularly cleaning vehicles wheels, the site entrance, and adjacent roads to keep the spread of muck down. Our traffic management plan is in place with restricted access times for vehicles entering and leaving site. The site traffic will increase over the next few weeks due to earth removal works which will be monitored closely to ensure the safety of the public, pedestrians and school children.

Work in the Community

The Covid-19 pandemic does prevent us from fully integrating with the community, but we will continue to work with the community and the school where possible. We are committed to engage and will be liaising with the school to look at what opportunities we can assist with relating to the school's curriculum.

School Feedback

The new school has been up and running now for 3 months and the feedback from the school has been very positive. The current pandemic has obviously brought additional challenges that come with settling into a new environment for the pupils and staff, but they are coping well and look forward to getting back to, new normality soon.

During the lockdown period a member of the Morrison Construction team Managed to build a LEGO version of the new school. We thought we would share a quick snap of how it turned out. Unlike the real build this version only took 3 months rather than 2 years to construct, but is a pretty good replica we think.
