Road Safety

We continue to carry out road safety checks across South Queensferry, focusing on roads whereby the majority of complaints have been received. We are utilising the hand-held speed radar (Speed Gun!) to target drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/ASB – 20+ reported incidents

The majority of incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae Car Park.

Several incidents also relate to vehicles racing/speeding in the areas of Borrowman Square, Hewlett Way, Station Road and Scotstoun Avenue.

The ongoing issues relating to anti-social driving in and around South Queensferry remain a priority, with considerable resources deployed, in addition to units responding to the above complaints.

Of note, we are pleased to note that the raised tables have now been agreed by the City of Edinburgh Council who have committed to install same in the coming months. We are hopeful this will, as was originally put forward, have a positive effect on the significant anti-social behavior, and dissuade drivers attending the area with intentions to speed and race around the car park.

From our side, we are planning to hold a targeted initiative in the coming weeks, requesting assistance from our colleagues in Roads Policing. This will be our fourth initiative of the year, alongside day to day high visibility patrols carried out as part of our patrol matrix.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 4 x reported incidents

1 x incident relates to youths on top of garages at William Black Place

2 x incidents relate to youths in a derelict site along Society Road

1 x incident relates to youths pulling down shutters of shops in the area of Scotstoun Grove
