Road Safety

We continue to carry out road safety checks across South Queensferry, focusing on roads whereby the majority of complaints have been received. We are utilising the hand-held speed radar (Speed Gun!) to target drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/ASB – 7 reported incidents

4 x incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae/Newhalls Road.

1 x incident relates to vehicles speeding/racing on Station Road.

1 x incident relates to a vehicle speeding on Scotstoun Avenue.

1 x incident relates to a vehicle with a loud exhaust in the area of Hewlett Way.

As referenced in last month's report, we conducted a targeted initiative over two nights, on the 17th & 18th October, alongside our colleagues in Roads Policing. We deployed a number of marked resources in the area of Hawes Brae Car Park and throughout South Queensferry, along with unmarked vehicles strategically placed on roads most often used by drivers coming to and from Hawes Brae. Numerous drivers were spoken to during the course of each night, vehicles monitored and checked for roadworthiness where proportionate, and formal action taken where any crimes were identified.

The ongoing issues relating to anti-social driving in and around South Queensferry will remain a priority given its impact of residents and members of the public.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 2 x reported incidents

1 x incident relates to youths on top of garages at Scotstoun Grove.

1 x incident relates to youths in a wooded area in near to Carlowrie Crescent.

Vandalism: No incidents reported

Bogus Caller: No incidents reported

Incident of note

The following appeal was launched by Police Scotland on 25/10/2024 following an incident at the Petrol Station at Ferrymuir Gait. If anybody has any knowledge, please get in touch:

Around 2.15pm on Friday, 25 October, 2024, a man was seen outside a petrol station at Ferrymuir Gait, South Queensferry.

A short time later he entered the premises, presented a bladed article and demanded money. He left with a small sum of cash.

The male staff member was unhurt and did not require medical treatment.

The suspect is described as being between 5ft 8ins and 5ft 10ins and of medium build. He was wearing a black beanie style hat with a grey trim, a grey snood which covered his mouth and nose. He was also wearing a brown coat with a fur trim collar and cuffs, blue jeans and white trainers. He wore blue gloves with writing on the rear of the left hand, was carrying a black backpack and he spoke with a local accent.

Reviewing CCTV is key part of this enquiry and officers are extensively working through all available footage. If you have local CCTV or were in the area and have dash-cam footage, please get in touch as you may have captured something that can assist our investigation.
