Road Safety

We continue to carry out road safety checks across South Queensferry, focusing on roads whereby the majority of complaints have been received. We are utilising the hand-held speed radar (Speed Gun!) to target drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/ASB – 28 reported incidents

The majority of incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae/Newhalls Road. Issues are being caused by a mixture of cars and motorbikes/off-road bikes.

All other incidents relate to loud exhausts, speeding or racing vehicles in the areas of Borrowman Sq, Packard St, Hewlett Way, Frairs Croft Crook, Station Road, Ferrymuir and the High Street.

Considerable efforts continue to be made by Officers across the NW, in an effort to tackle this longstanding issue. Both Euan and I have recently met in person with numerous residents from the Newhalls Road area, with positive outcomes and action points. We intend to carry out a number of targeted initiatives over the next six months in the run up to Summer, to address any anticipated escalation as we move back towards better weather and brighter nights.

We're hopeful additional resources will be available, including specialist traffic Officers, to most effectively disrupt and dissuade any drivers partaking in dangerous or anti-social driving/behaviour.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 1 x reported incident

Incident relates to youths refusing to leave McDonalds, Builyeon Road – No crimes.

Vandalism: 1 x reported incident

Incident relates to damage to vehicles in the area of Stoneycroft Road – Enquiries ongoing.

Bogus Caller: No incidents reported
