Road Safety

Speed checks continue across the ward, targeting drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so. This remains a focus for us, with numerous complaints received from concerned members of the public.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/Noise Pollution – 14 x reported incidents

The majority of incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae/Newhalls Road, with issues caused by a mixture of cars and motorbikes. However, there were also reports from other areas of South Queensferry.

2 x reports relate to youths on off-road bikes in the areas of Sandercombe Drive and the Dalmeny Estate.

Dedicated patrols have been carried out over the past month by both the Roads Policing and Community Policing Teams. Formal action was taken against a number of drivers, the most recent being Friday evening (19/09) whereby a driver was issued with an anti-social behaviour warning following their actions in the area of Hawes Brae whilst we were present.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 2 x reported incidents

1 x incident relates to youths causing banging at the door of a property in the area of Dimma Park.

1 x incident relates to youths within Inchgarvie House.

Vandalism: 1 x reported incident

Incident relates to damage to a vehicle in the area of Sommerville Gardens – Enquiries ongoing.

Bogus Caller: No incidents reported
