Road Safety

Speed checks continue across the ward, targeting drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so. This remains a focus for us, with numerous complaints received from concerned members of the public.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/Noise Pollution – 8 x reported incidents

5 x incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae/Newhalls Road, with issues caused by a mixture of cars and motorbikes.

3 x incidents relate to off-road bikes causing a nuisance and riding in a dangerous manner in the area of Carlowrie Avenue.

Whilst reported incidents are significantly lower than during Summer months, Officers are still carrying out patrols of the area around Hawes Brae and South Queensferry as a whole to dissuade anti-social driving.

Additionally, whilst the temporary camera that had been in place for the past few years, has been removed, we can confirm that, having attended the CCTV suite, the new camera installed next to the toilet block is well-placed and does capture the car park as a whole. Furthermore, said camera is situated at a more advantageous angle to capture drivers entering and leaving the car park. We're still hopeful a second camera will be installed, however this decision lies with the City of Edinburgh Council.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 2 x reported incidents

1 x incident relates to intoxicated youths congregating in the area of Gote Lane.

1 x incident relates to youths causing a nuisance in the area of Dimma Park.

Vandalism: 6 x reported incident

1 x incident relates to graffiti in the underpass at Morrison Gardens – Crime report created and request sent to cleansing team for said graffiti to be removed.

5 x incidents relate to vehicles damaged in the area of Stewart Clark Avenue/William Black Place – Crime reports will be created for each incident.
