Road Safety

Speed checks continue across the ward, targeting drivers failing to abide by speed limits, with formal action taken where it is proportionate to do so. This remains a focus for us, with numerous complaints received from concerned members of the public.

Anti-Social Driving/Speeding/Noise Pollution – 7 x reported incidents

All incidents relate to complaints of anti-social driving/noise related issues in the area of Hawes Brae/Newhalls Road and Station Road.

Similar to last month, Officers have taken formal action against a number of drivers, ranging from warnings to charges including careless driving, driving without valid insurance, driving without a valid license etc.

Anti-social Behaviour/Youth Disorder: 5 x reported incidents

3 x incidents relate to youths causing a nuisance in the area of East Terrace – Officers have spoken with residents, providing suitable advice, and will be conducting additional patrols in the area where possible.

1 x incident relates to youths throwing stones at a property on Hope Street – Officers attended and spoke with the residents affected, with subsequent efforts made to identify the youths responsible.

1 x incident relates to youths allegedly entering a building site near to East Biggers Brae.

Vandalism: 5 x reported incidents

All five incidents relate to graffiti containing offensive language at various locations around South Queensferry, most prominently at Morrison Gardens and Society Road – This series of offences follows on from previous incidents, a number of which were not reported to Police. Considerable enquiry is ongoing to identify the person/persons responsible.

In addition to above, Officers are carrying out both high visibility and plain clothes patrols in and around the areas most affected. A CCTV camera has also been requested for installation near to Morrison Gardens in an effort to deter further graffiti in that area.

If anybody has any information or evidence as to who may be responsible for the aforementioned graffiti, please contact Police on 101 to pass on this information.
